



## DeltaGraph 5.5 for Mac OS X

### Key Features in DeltaGraph 5.5

DeltaGraph 5.5 Mac is an update to v.5.02.

New and improved features include:

Drag and Drop charts and objects from DeltaGraph to other applications

Support for Transparency on all chart elements, transparency is maintained after export (except PICT and EPS export)

Quartz soft drop shadows, shadows are maintained with export (except PICT and EPS)

Improved export image resolution with JPG up to 1200 dpi

PDF import/export

Copy/Paste custom delimited data

Full rendered Quartz text

### Important Notes for the Reviewer

#### System Requirements

Your computer should meet these minimum requirements to run DeltaGraph 5.5:

**Processor** - Macintosh Power PC, G3 or later

**Operating System** - Mac OS 9.2 or Mac OS X version 10.1.5 or later

**Memory** - 128 MB of RAM or more

**Drives** - Internal hard drive with 50 MB free space and Mac OS Extended (HFS+) format, the default format for Mac OS X

**Display** - Minimum of 256 colors and a resolution of 800x600 or higher

**Note** - To see if your computer meets these requirements, use the Apple System Profiler utility. Go to Applications, open the Utilities folder, and double-click Apple System Profiler. The System Profile tab shows you system and processor.

**Installing DeltaGraph 5.5** - Before installing DeltaGraph, quit any programs that are running, including virus protection and screen saver programs, because they might interfere with installation. If you have the "Classic" environment running (Mac OS 9), end it before starting installation.

#### To install DeltaGraph 5.5:

1. Insert the DeltaGraph 5.5 CD into your CD-ROM drive.
2. Open the DeltaGraph 5.5 CD, and double-click Install DeltaGraph. The Welcome window is displayed.
3. Click Continue to proceed. Follow the on-screen directions.



**Examples** - In the following examples you will be shown the new features in DeltaGraph 5.5. If this is the first time you have worked with DeltaGraph please start with Reveiwer's Guide I.

### **Example #1:**

#### **Drag and Drop DeltaGraph charts to other applications**

After you have installed DeltaGraph you will be presented with a blank data sheet. Since we will be working with chart elements in this example do not worry about the empty data sheet.

To create your first chart select Chart from the menu bar. Then select Chart Gallery from the drop down menu. Select column chart from the upper left hand corner of the dialogue box. Then select use sample data from the Plot Options and Plot In "new page". Select Okay. You will be presented with a standard column chart.

Now open Microsoft PowerPoint>New presentation> Chart template. Now drag and drop your DeltaGraph column chart into PowerPoint. The DeltaGraph chart will size properly and drop into PowerPoint.

### **Example #2:**

#### **Transparency Control and Quartz Drop Shadows**

Using the same DeltaGraph column chart that you have just created. Click on a single column of the chart. From the tool palette on the left of the chart window select the bottom most panel to adjust transparency. To apply the Quartz soft drop shadows select a column>select Draw from the menu bar>select Shadows... Select remove "none">Shadow Type select Quartz then select OK. Once you have adjusted transparency and applied Quartz drop shadows, select File from the menu bar, then select export. Export the DeltaGraph file to your desktop as a PDF. If you are on "Panther" use F11 to move all open windows and select your DeltaGraph file to reopen as a PDF. Transparency and drop shadows will be maintained.

### **Example # 3:**

#### **Using JPG Resolution Slider.**

Using the same DeltaGraph column chart that you have created click once on the chart to select the chart, then choose File from the menu bar. Select Export>Other. Select JPG Image from the dialogue box then select Options. Under Options select "High" then OK.

If you are on "Panther" select F11 to clear all open windows and find your DeltaGraph JPG file. Open this file, or if you still have PowerPoint open select Insert> New chart>Chart Template then OK. Then drag your DeltaGraph JPG into PowerPoint. Transparency and Quartz shadows will be maintained.
